

702 The Greater Stockholm

When visiting Stockholm, why not combine it with some great excursion! During this tour you will see Stockholm, enjoy a cruise to Drottningholm castle, see the beautiful wooden town of Sigtuna and glorious Uppsala as well as Mariefred with its Gripsholm's Castle. You will stay in a hotel in Stockholm throughout the tour.

Day 1: Arrival in Stockholm

You will arrive in Stockholm individually by plane. At the airport you will be picked up and brought to your hotel where you will stay for the next few days. Seize the evening and collect first impressions of this amazing city.

Day 2: Stockholm

After breakfast in your hotel, you will set out for a 3-hour city tour. The city guide will show you all impressive sights of the city such as the Royal Castle, the picturesque Old Town "Gamla Stan" or the "Stadhuset" where the annually Nobel Prize Award ceremony takes place.

In the following, you will visit one of the most popular museums of whole Scandinavia: the Vasa-Museum. Vasa is the only existing ship of the 17th century worldwide and is known as an outstanding tourism attraction.

The evening can be organized yourself. Enjoy a cup of tea or coffee in the traditional Grand Hotel or linger around the beautiful Old Town "Gamla Stan".

Day 3: Excursion Drottningholm Castle

After having breakfast in your hotel, you will along with a local guide head for a trip to Drottningholm castle. By boat, you will experience one of the most beautiful attractions in Stockholm's surrounding. Arrived in Drottningholm, you will get first impressions of its beauty. The former summer residence of the king is today's domicile of the Royal family. The Castle houses a baroque park and majestic premises of the 17th, 18th and 19th century. Drottningholm castle is part of UNESCO world heritage sites (Entrance fee included).

In the afternoon you will travel back to your hotel and the remaining day will be at your own disposal.

Day 4: Excursion Gripsholm Castle in Mariefred

After your breakfast you will travel together with your tour guide to your next highlight of Stockholm's surroundings. Gripsholm Castle owes its popularity to Kurt Tucholsky who wrote a famous novel of the same name. The renaissance Castle has been built more than 450 years ago and houses the Swedish National Portrait Gallery. You will visit the castle and take part in a guided tour (entrance fee is included). After this visit you will return to Stockholm where you will have the remaining day off.

Day 5: Visit in Uppsala and Sigtuna

After the morning breakfast you set out to Uppsala and Sigtuna, both located near Stockholm. Your guide will give you all necessary information. Sigtuna, besides Lund, is the oldest existing city in Sweden. Excavations show that the city has been founded by King Erik Segersäll in 980. Furthermore, the cultural center "Steninge Slott" with shows

and lively culture and the Royal Castle “Rosersberg” are waiting for you to be visited (entrance fees not included).

The next stop of your day trip is Uppsala, Sweden’s second oldest University City which offers sights such as the Dome Cathedral (entrance fee included), Viking Museum or the Castle which is located over the roofs of the city. In the evening you will travel back to the airport Stockholm-Arlanda and fly back home.
