

115 Fjord Norway – One Location

During three full day excursions you will get to know the beauty and variety of the impressive Norwegian fjord landscape. During four nights you will stay at the same comfortable resort hotel surrounded by mountains with generous sized rooms, an indoor swimming pool and the possibility for Spa-treatments.

Day 1: Arrival in Kiel

In Kiel you board the ferry of Stena Line to Gothenburg. Accommodation on board.

Day 2: Göteborg – Gol (ca. 490 km)

After breakfast you travel along the Swedish west coast via Uddevalla to the Norwegian boarder near Svinesund. Having passed Oslo, Hønefoss and the beautiful Hallingdal-valley you will finally reach your booked hotel in the region of Gol. Gol is surrounded by breathtaking mountains and is well-known as a holiday destination. Accommodation for the next 4 nights in the area of Gol.

Day 3: Day trip “Stave churches and Salmons” (ca. 240km)

After breakfast you travel across the mountains of Hemsedal, one of the biggest and most popular Ski resorts in Scandinavia and reach Borgund where you visit the beautiful stave church (guided tour included). Later on you travel along the well-known salmon-river Lærdalselva to Lærdal at the Sognefjord. Here you will visit the “Norwegian wild-salmon centre” including a movie screening. That followed, you will have some time off for a walk through the historic centre of the village with all its amazing wooden houses. In the afternoon you drive back to your hotel in Gol.

Day 4: Day trip Fjords and mountains (ca. 300 km)

After breakfast you start your day trip to Flåm where you will take the popular Flåm-train to Myrdal on the Hardanger plateau. On the way you will stop near a waterfall amongst other places for taking pictures. After the arrival back in Flåm (ca. 2,5 hours) you take the boat and drive on the Aurlands- and Nærøyfjord (both side arms of the spanning Sognefjord) to Gudvangen. The Nærøyfjord can not be reached on a road and is the narrowest fjord in Norway (ca. 1,5 hours). In the following, there is the possibility to do a side trip up the Stalheim mountain pass until Stalheim Hotel in order to have the breathtaking view over the landscape. After this experience you return via Flåm and Geilo to Gol.

Day 5: Day Trip Hardangerfjord (ca. 290km)

After breakfast you drive across the Hardanger plateau and visit the impressive Vøringsfossen waterfall. Through the Mabø canyon you reach Eidjord next to the beautiful Hardanger fjord. Here, you visit the nature centre of the national park where you watch an imposing movie. In the following, you will visit the solitary farm “Kjeåsen” which is located high above the Hardanger fjord. In the afternoon you will travel back to Gol.

Day 6: Gol – Oslo (ca. 190km)

After the breakfast buffet you will travel to Oslo where you will take part in a two-hour city tour. The tour guide will show you all important places in Oslo such as the city hall,

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Holmenkollen or the Vigelandpark. The remaining day is for your own leisure time. Take a walk through Studentlunden or get a coffee in the traditional Grand Café. In the evening you board the ship of Stena Line which will bring you to Frederikshavn.

Day 7: Arrival Frederikshavn – Return journey

Arrival in Fredrikshavn in the morning and homeward journey.
