

## **302 Midnight Sun At The North Cape**

**In nice convenient legs, you travel on the classic route from Oslo to the North Cape in Norway and back along the “High Coast” through Sweden to Stockholm. The end of the tour offers a comfortable night onboard the night ferry to Mainland Europe.**

### **Day 1: Puttgarden-Kopenhagen-Ängelholm (240 km)**

On your first day you will take the ferry from Puttgarden to Rødby. From Rødby you travel to Copenhagen where you will take part in a guided city tour in the afternoon. The guide will present you the highlights of the city such as the Town Hall, Tivoli, castle Amalienborg and “The little Mermaid”. After another ferry crossing you arrive to Sweden and your final destination for today: Ängelholm.

### **Day 2: Ängelholm-Oslo (560 km)**

After a nutritious breakfast you will drive towards north via Gothenburg to Oslo. On location a guide will show you Oslo’s most important sites such as the Town Hall, Vigelandpark and the new opera house. Overnight stay in the Oslo area.

### **Day 3: Oslo-Trondheim (550 km)**

After breakfast, you will travel towards Trondheim passing Mjøsa Lake with its many beautiful swimming areas and the city of Lillehammer. In Lillehammer the Olympic Winter Games of 1994 took place and still today many visitors are delighted when visiting this nice city. Furthermore, the city of Lillehammer houses one of the biggest Open Air Museums of Northern Europe “Maihaugen”. On your continued way to Trondheim you will also pass Gudbrandsdalen, the town of Dombås, crossing the Dovrefjell mountain pass until you finally reach the destination for today. Overnight stay in the Trondheim area.

### **Day 4: Trondheim - Mo i Rana (480 km)**

After breakfast you will travel from Trondheim via Gron and Mosjøen to Mo i Rana. In this small city you will stay for the night.

### **Day 5: Mo i Rana – Finnsnes (545 km)**

Today you are crossing the Arctic Circle! After your breakfast you will continue your journey, passing the Glacier area “Svartisen” towards north. Near Narvik you can enjoy the fantastic view over the Ofotfjord before traveling to Finnsnes where you will spend the next night of your trip.

### **Day 6: Finnsnes – Nordkap (560 km)**

After breakfast you continue your journey towards the North Cape passing the breathtaking Lyngen Fjord via Skibotn and along the Alta Fjord until the city of Alta. In this region one cannot distinguish between night and day in period between May until the beginning of August. The North Cape Cliff offers an unforgettable view over the Arctic Sea and in case of good weather conditions, you will be able to see the midnight sun (entrance for North Cape Hall is not included). You will spend the night in a nice guest house.

## **Day 7: Nordkap – Sirkka (550 km)**

As the days before, you start your day with a breakfast before leaving the guest house and traveling to the Home of the Sami people, Kautokeino. Near Enontekiö you will pass the finish border and drive along the border river until you reach Sirkka where you will spend the night.

## **Day 8: Sirkka – Umeå (690 km)**

After the breakfast you will travel to Umeå. On your way you will pass Luleå. Near Luleå the very interesting city “Gammelstaden” is located where several churches can be visited. “Gammelstaden” has been nominated as a UNESCO world heritage site. In the late afternoon, you will reach Umeå on the Swedish east coast. Here you will check in into your hotel room for the night.

## **Day 9: Umeå – Bollnäs (420 km)**

You will have breakfast in Umeå before you travel to Bollnäs. When you passed Örnköldsvik the most beautiful part of the Swedish east coast starts – the “High Coast”. Due to its fantastic and unique panorama of the sea and the landside, this area has been set on the list of UNESCO world heritage sites. When you reach Bollnäs, you will check in into your hotel room.

## **Day 10: Bollnäs - Stockholm (250 km)**

Today you will travel to Sweden’s capital! After the breakfast you will drive to Stockholm via Gävle. Arriving in Stockholm, you will meet a tour guide who shows you the most interesting sides of the city. Built on 14 islands, situated between Lake Mälaren and the archipelago with its 24,000 islands, you will discover the beauty of this city including sights such as the Royal Castle and the old town “Gamla Stan”. Spend the rest of the day in the lively city or relax in one of many restaurants! Overnight stay in the Stockholm area.

## **Day 11: Stockholm - Trelleborg (640 km)**

After a delicious breakfast you set out for your way to Trelleborg. In addition, you will have the possibility to drive via Mariefred and visit Gripsholm castle. Kurt Tucholsky wrote a popular novel of the same name and boosted therefore the level of popularity dramatically. You drive on and reach Sweden’s deepest lake, Lake Vättern. In order to reach Trelleborg, you will cross Småland, the home of Astrid Lindgren’s stories. After you have reached Trelleborg you will go aboard of the cruise line ship TT-Line which will bring you to Travemünde.

## **Day 12: Arrival in Travemünde**

In the morning you will arrive in Travemünde where you leave the ship after having breakfast onboard.
