

336 Fjords With Hurtigruten

During this journey you will experience the breathtaking journey through the Geirangerfjord aboard the Hurtigruten. Also the other days are packed with impressive and unforgettable nature experiences as only the fjord landscape can offer!

Day 1: To Travemünde (or Rostock)

Ferry crossing from Travemünde to Trelleborg with TT-Line. Accommodation on board.

Day 2: Trelleborg-Oslo (ca. 590 km)

Breakfast on board. Arrival to Trelleborg in the morning. Journey along the Swedish west coast to Oslo. Overnight stay in the Oslo area.

Day 3: Oslo-Otta (ca. 295 km)

After breakfast you will set out for your 3-hour city tour in Oslo. The experienced city guide will show you all sightseeing highlights of Norway's capital such as the Vigeland-Park, the new opera house or the museum-peninsula "Bygdøy" where you visit the Viking ship museum (entrance included). After the tour you drive on along Lake Mjøsa via Lillehammer to the area of Otta where you will stay for one night.

Day 4: Otta-Ålesund (ca. 265 km)

After your breakfast you set off and travel through the wonderful Gudbrands- and Romsdal-Valleys. Before you arrive to Ålesund, you cross the famous Trollstigen on a spectacular road! Ålesund houses the biggest fishing harbor of Norway and enchants its visitors with an Art Nouveau built city center. On the island of "Giske" a marmoreal church is located which was put up by a Viking prince in the Middle Ages. You will spend your night in a hotel in Ålesund.

Day 5: Ålesund-Geiranger Fjord - Førde

Today you will experience one of the journey's highlights! You board a ship of the famous "Hurtigruten" (coastal steamer). The route of Hurtigruten is described as "the most beautiful sea passages in the world". Through Storfjord you travel into the spectacular Geirangerfjord and enjoy the impressive landscape! In Geiranger your coach is waiting for you for your onward journey to Lom. On the way you will again enjoy a spectacular mountain road. In addition you have the possibility for a side trip to the glacier of "Briksdal" which is part of the huge "Jostedal" glacier, one of the biggest glaciers in Europe. Overnight stay in Førde.

Day 6: Førde-Bergen (ca. 170 km)

After breakfast you continue your journey towards Bergen. On the way you will cross the majestic Sognefjord by ferry. In Bergen a local guide will show you the city including all important sights such as the old hanseatic quarter "Bryggen" which is a UNESCO world heritage site as well as Maria church from the middle age. You will be charmed by the city's atmosphere. The night will be spent in a hotel outside the city center.

Day 7: Bergen-Gol (ca. 290 km)

After your breakfast you will be traveling to the Hardangerfjord. On the way you will stop at the Steindalsfossen waterfall. The Hardanger area is famous for the many orchards and the beautiful landscape with the fjord, mountains and glaciers. The Hardangerfjord is being crossed by ferry. After Eidfjord the road is winding up to the mountain plateau of the Hardangervidda. Here you will enjoy the view of one of the biggest waterfalls in Norway. Overnight stay in the area of Gol.

Day 8: Gol-Oslo (ca. 195 km)

After breakfast you travel through the picturesque Hallingdal valley and along Lake Krøderen to Oslo. In the early afternoon your luxurious ferry boat to Kiel leaves the capital of Norway through the Oslofjord. Accommodation on board.

Day 9: Arrival in Kiel

Breakfast on board the ferry.
