

101 North Cape at Low Cost

The North Cape does not have to be expensive! On well-maintained roads you will easily reach Lapland and the North Cape with some interesting sights such as the “Storfosen” rapids on the way. On your way back you will travel through Dalarna.

Tag 1: Puttgarden – Ängelholm

Your journey starts with ferry crossings from Puttgarden to Rødby and from Helsingør to Helsingborg. You are reaching Sweden and stay for one night in the city of Ängelholm which is well known for its salmon-fishing and its cuckoo-flutes made of clay.

Tag 2: Ängelholm – Stockholm (550 km)

After breakfast you will travel to the Swedish capital. Having passed the Vättern-Lake and the cities of Linköping and Norrköping, you will reach Stockholm in the afternoon. *Optional city sightseeing tour.* The remaining day is reserved for your own interests. You can use the time to visit one of many museums such as Vasa-Museum or Skansen or you stroll through the narrow streets of the old town “Gamla Stan”.

Tag 3: Stockholm – Umeå (650 km)

After your breakfast you travel along the Swedish east coast, passing the cities of Söderhamn and Sundsvall until Umeå. In the University City Umeå you will find your booked accommodation for the following night.

Tag 4: Umeå – Pello (460 km)

Today, you will journey to Finland. After your breakfast, you travel along the west coast of Sweden up north. Finally, you will reach your today’s destination: Pello. Pello is located only 100 meters away from the Swedish boarder and belongs to the finish part of Lapland. In Pello, you will stay for one night.

Tag 5: Pello – Nordkap (635 km)

Today you will finally reach the North Cape! After your breakfast you leave Pello and drive towards the north. You pass through the fascinating area north of the arctic circle and in the afternoon you reach the North Cape. In the period of mid may until august you cannot distinguish between night and day! The North Cape cliff offers a breathtaking view over the arctic sea and if the visibility conditions allow it, you can see the midnight sun. You will spend the night in a comfy guesthouse.

Tag 6: Nordkap – Gratangen (680 km)

After a night at the North Cape, you will travel towards the Norwegian coast. Passing Alta where one can find more than 1000 petro graphs of the Sami people, you will pass Bardufoss and reach Gratangen. Next to a fjord of the same name, it was the site of the Norwegian invasion of German troupes during World War II. Today, nothing of this happened scenario reminds the sightseer. The picturesque landscape bewitches the visitors and invites them to stay. Here in Gratangen you will stay over night.

Tag 7: Gratangen – Norsjö (660 km)

After having a nutritious breakfast, you betake yourself to the Swedish village of Norsjö in the region Västerbotten. On the way you will have the possibility to visit the breathtaking rapids of “Storforsen”.

Norsjö is a small community with typical Swedish flair. Here, you can enjoy the nature, give yourself a rest and go for a walk. Relax in one of the small cozy cafés or visit the park which offers mini golf and a hunting museum.

Tag 8: Norsjö – Falun (760 km)

Your journey brings you through Hälsingland, via Dalarna to Falun where your next hotel accommodation is located. 85 % of Hälsingland are covered with forest. Maybe you spot the king of the forest, the moose? On your way across the area of Dalarna you will see the typical Swedish landscape: forest and red timber houses. The typical red color of the houses or huts, you discover all over Sweden, has its origin in Falun. With the help of copper this color has been produced. Furthermore, you can view the beautiful Siljan Lake which is famous for its special nuance of blue, the Siljan-blue. In Falun you will stay for one night.

Tag 9: Falun – Ängelholm (620 km)

After a homelike breakfast you will go on your way to Ängelholm. You are passing the area of Västergötland and Småland. By the way, many storybook characters of Astrid Lindgren live in Småland. When you have reached Ängelholm you will check in into you booked hotel.

Tag 10: Ängelholm – Puttgarden

After a last breakfast you travel from Ängelholm to Helsingør and finally to Puttgarden by ferry. Arriving in Puttgarden, you will take your homeward journey.
