Norway is famous for its beautiful nature - the fjords, mountains and waterfalls. This tour includes it all! When travelling by train and boat you have the perfect opportunity to sit back and enjoy the spectacular scenery. You will also have the opportunity to explore Norway's two most well known cities; Oslo and Bergen.

Day 01: Arrival in Oslo

Arrive in Oslo according to your own itinerary. The Norwegian capital is beautifully situated at the head of the Oslo Fjord and surrounded by forested ridges. Oslo offers many well know sights such as the Vigeland Sculpture Park, the Viking Ship Museum, and the Munch Museum. Accommodation at Rica Hotel Oslo

Day 02: Oslo

Breakfast at the hotel. Day at your own lesiure. We recommend a 3 hour sightseeing tour by bus, including Oslo city centre, Vigeland Sculpture Park, Holmenkollen Ski Museum and the Kon-tiki Museum. The tour departs from the City Hall Pier nb. 3 every day at 11:00 hrs, Accommodation at Rica Hotel Oslo.

Day 03: Oslo - Geilo (train)

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning departure from Oslo by train. The 4-hour journey from Oslo to Geilo is part of the Oslo – Bergen Railway, classed as one of the finest train journeys in the world. The railway connects Norway's two largest cities and presents the variety of Norwegian scenery.

Accommodation at Bardøla Hotel

Day 04: Geilo – Sognefjord – Leikanger (train/boat)

Breakfast at the hotel. Today the journey continues by train to Myrdal, where you will change to the Flåm Railway. The Flåm Railway passes through wild and beautiful mountain scenery with waterfalls and steep mountain sides from a height of 900 metres and down to the Sognefjord. There is no other adhesion railway in the world running on normal tracks that is so steep over a long distance. From Flåm you continue by boat on the Sognefjord, Europe's longest and deepest fjord, to the village of Leikanger.
Accommodation at Leikanger Fjord hotel

Day 05: Leikanger – Sognefjord – Bergen (boat)

Breakfast at the hotel. Continue from Leikanger by boat on the Sognefjord and then along the coast headed south to Bergen – the Gateway to the Fjords. Bergen is Norway's second largest city and the world's only city surrounded by 7 mountains and 7 fjords.
Accommodation at Augustin Hotel

Day 06: Bergen

Breakfast at the hotel. Day at your leisure, Bergen offers many attractions and sights to mention but a few, we suggest a visit to the Hanseatic Bryggen Harbour, Fløibanen Funicular, Troidhaugen, the Fish and Flower market, Bergen Aquarium and Gamle Bergen (Old Bergen Open Air Museum).
Accommodation at Augustin Hotel

Day 07: Departure from Bergen

Breakfast at the hotel.
Departure from Bergen according to your own itinerary.
